

Frequently Asked Questions

Q Can my child be in the same cabin as her/his friend? Campers automatically stay together as long as they are the same gender, in the same age group and in the same program. Since Riverside, Mini Camp, Splashdown and Horseback are multi-cabin programs, campers in these programs must request to be placed in the same cabin with a friend. They'll be making new friends, too.

Q Can my child call home or email while at camp? Campers do not have phone or email access while at camp. They'll be having way too much fun! Campers receive mail each day, so friends and family are encouraged to send letters and email.

Q What are my payment options? All summer camp balances are due by June 1, 2010, fall camp balances are due by September 24, 2010, and winter camp balances are due by December 1, 2010. You can choose to pay all at one time or make monthly installments. We accept cash, checks, money orders, MasterCard, VISA, Discover, and American Express. Automated clearing house (ACH) drafts may also be authorized with final payments for summer camp being made no later than September 15, 2010. Finances should never prevent a child from attending Camp Pecometh. Please contact us if you need to make other arrangements, such as a regular payment plan.

Q How will I know if I get the program I choose when I register online? You will not be able to register online for a program that is no longer available. All registrations require a \$50 deposit, which you can pay by credit card. If you mail your registration, you will receive your confirmation in the mail.

Q Will I receive a confirmation if I register online? Yes, you will receive a confirmation via the email address that you provided when registering. We will provide links in the email to our website so that you can download and print the necessary instructions and forms. You will not receive a confirmation in the mail, as that helps us keep our costs down (and saves a few trees in the process!)

Q What are the benefits of registering online? Most importantly, you will find out immediately if your child receives his/her first choice. Online registration still gives you the option of paying by credit card, as well as paying only a modest deposit at the time of registration and paying the balance due when camp nears.

Q When does camp fill up? Our most popular programs fill up within a couple of months of when the brochure is distributed, so the earlier you get your registration in, the better. Our higher capacity programs, such as Riverside, may have openings into the summer. Fall Frenzy and Winter Wonder camps do have limited space available. Don't think you've waited too long for your children to have a great camp time Pecometh. Call us and we'll do everything possible to find them a spot.

Q Can I come and see camp before I sign up? We have an Open House scheduled for Saturday, April 24, 2010 (11am – 4pm) and Sunday, April 25, 2010 (Noon – 4pm). We suggest, however, that you register for camp before that to ensure that your child has a spot. If you come to Open House and determine camp isn't what you were looking for, we'll return your deposit.

Q With whom will my child be spending his/her day? Camper's spend their day in "family groups" which is typically comprised of a girls' cabin and a boys' cabin. Family groups move through daily activities such as canteen, Bible study, pool, arts & crafts, etc. as a unit. Most evening activities are "all-camp" activities such as counselor hunt, campfire, or international spotlight. Family Groups stay together during these activities, but are typically part of the larger group. Fall Frenzy and Winter Wonder camps will spend their day with campers in their age group.

Q Will Camp contact me in the event of an emergency? Yes, we will contact you if...

- Your camper is ill, with a fever over 100 degrees
- Your camper has to be taken to the camp doctor (this does not include visits to the camp nurse)
- Your camper has to be taken to the hospital
- Your camper is unable to function within the Camp Pecometh guidelines for living
