Welcome to Camp Pecometh! Day Camp is the perfect opportunity for kids who have completed grades K thru 5 who want all the fun of a camp experience without having to spend the night away from home. Campers participate in many of the Riverside activities, from arts & crafts to Bible study to swimming. Camp hours are from 8am to 5pm, Monday through Friday. Extended hours are available (7am to 6pm), please call the Registrar for additional information.

Your camper will need to bring their lunch and drink each day (refrigeration available). We will provide two snacks during the day.

Please be sure to bring your health form along with any medications to check-in. **Without your health form, completed by your doctor, you will not be permitted to stay.** Your Day Camp Base will be the Pool Pavilion. Parents will need to drop off and pick up their camper at the Pool Pavilion. While your camper is at Pecometh, they will have a cubby to use for any items which they'd like to keep at Pecometh for the week.
